NOTICE OF CRM PUBLIC HEARING

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW) TINIAN ROUTE 205 EXTENSION ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

The Division of Coastal Resources Management (DCRM) will be holding a public hearing for the following three projects:

<u>CRM Major Siting Application No. TMS-2024-044</u> – The Route 205 extension road improvement project area is located at the southside of Tinian, just the east of the former Tinian Dynasty Hotel and Casino. The road to be paved is the existing gravel road from Route 205/Route 206 intersection to Route 27 intersection. The project includes improvements to the drainage system, drainage conveyance to the ponding basin, and utility adjustments. The total length of the road improvement project is approximately 3,700 linear feet (0.7 miles).

The public hearing for this project isscheduled on Tuesday, June 11, 2024, at 5:00PM, at the Tinian Elementary School Cafeteria, San Jose, Tinian.
