# NOTICE OF CRM PUBLIC HEARING

## COMMONWEALTH UTILITIES CORPORATION CONSTRUCTION OF THE 1.2 MW SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC SYSTEM WITH BATTERY STORAGE BUILDING

The Division of Coastal Resources Management (DCRM) will be holding a public hearing for the following project:

CRM Major Siting Application No. SMS-2026-011 The Commonwealth Utilities Corporation (CUC) is proposing to construct a 1.2 MW solar photovoltaic system with battery storage to support CUC's power generation, alongside a multi-level administrative facility for operations including customer service, engineering, Human Resources, and power division. The project is located on 25,000 to 29,899 square meters of public land, identified as Lot No. 1794NEW-R1 in Chalan Kiya, Saipan.

The public hearing for this project is scheduled for **Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 5:00 PM**, at the **DCRM Learning Center, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Gualo Rai Center II, Chalan Pale Arnold Road, Saipan.**
