MUNICIPALITY OF TINIAN AND AGUIGUAN MUNICIPALITY OF TINIAN AND AGUIGUAN CIVIC CENTER

The Division of Coastal Resources Management (DCRM) will be holding a public hearing for the following project:

CRM Major Siting Application No. TMS-2026-016 The Municipality of Tinian and Aguiguan (MOTA) is proposing to construct a Municipality of Tinian and Aguiguan Civic Center that will centralize nearly all local government functions into a single resilient facility. The building is designed to house the Mayor's Office, Senate Chambers, public agencies, and community-use space, and will also serve the island's emergency operations center during disasters. The project is located on 20,000 square meters of public lands, identified as Lot No. 241 T 25, 241 T 34, & 241 T 33 in San Jose, Tinian.

The public hearing for this project is scheduled for **Thursday, March 05, 2026 at 5:00 PM**, at the **Bar-K Diner on Canal St in San Jose, Tinian**.
