NOTICE OF CRM PUBLIC HEARING

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW)

PHASE III AND PHASE IV OF ROUTE 33 BEACH ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

The Division of Coastal Resources Management (DCRM) will be holding a public hearing for the following project:

CRM Major Siting Application No. CRM-MS2022-0001 (formerly SMS-2022-062) – The Department of Public Works (DPW) is proposing to commence Phase III and Phase IV of the Route 33 Beach Road Improvement Project. Phase III will begin from Route 33/Route 31 Intersection, in front of the former Marianas Visitors Authority (MVA) building in Chalan Laolao, to Angaha Street, before the RNV Construction and Horiguchi buildings in South Garapan. Phase IV begins on Angaha Street in South Garapan to Micro Beach Road and American Memorial Park (AMP) Intersection in North Garapan.

The public hearing for this project is scheduled on **Thursday, December 1, 2022, at 5:00PM, at the DCRM Learning Center 3rd Floor, Suite 301, Gualo Rai Center, Chalan Pale Arnold Road in Lower Gualo Rai, Saipan.**
