CONTEST RULES 2021 Annual Art Challenge

Criteria for Art & Description:

Each entry must be composed of a piece of artwork and a description (on the entry form). All must meet the requirements below.

Eligibility:

All students in grades **4th to 12th** across the CNMI enrolled in a recognized public, private, and home school is eligible to participate. Students must work individually.

ARTWORK & DESCRIPTION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. One entry per student
- 2. The entries must be on a single sheet of 8.5' x 11" paper, landscape.
- 3. Use white, non-glossy paper; do not laminate.
- 4. The artwork must be hand-drawn. Any computer graphics will not be accepted.
- 5. Any art medium may be used (e.g., colored pencils, crayons, paint).
- 6. Artwork must be flat (e.g., no glued pieces or glitter) and be able to be scanned.
- 7. Avoid labeling any brand names in the artwork.
- 8. A description of no more than 100 words must accompany the artwork in the space provided on the entry form. Do not write descriptions on artwork.
- 9. Label each entry on the back page of the artwork in pencil with the following:

Student's name, age, and grade

Teacher's name

School name

Entry Form Info:

There should be one entry form filled out per student. Please ensure that the entry form is filled out completely and legibly. All entries (entry form + artwork) must be submitted to the BECQ office no later than Thursday, November 18, 2021.

Competition Process:

A DCRM awards panel will collect all entries and select 13 winners based on the proportion of entries received from different grade levels and one overall winner. Entries (artwork and description) will be judged on the creativity, artistic presentation, and relevancy to the theme.
