NOTICE: The Bureau of Environmental and Coastal Quality (BECQ) Division of Coastal Resources Management (DCRM) is currently reviewing federal consistency certifications for the following:

- 1) CNMI Department of Public Lands (DPL) renewal of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit MP0020371 for the Managaha Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (OTWS).
- 2) Mobil Oil Mariana Islands, Inc. renewal of NPDES permit MP0020397 for the Mobil Saipan Terminal in Lower Base, Saipan.

The proposed activities are subject to review for consistency under the policies of the CNMI coastal management program (CMP).
