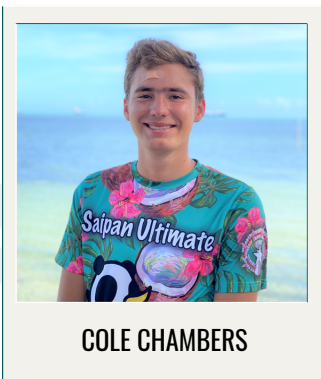




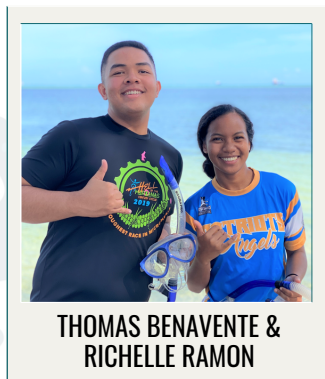
# MEET DCRM'S 2020 Summer Interns

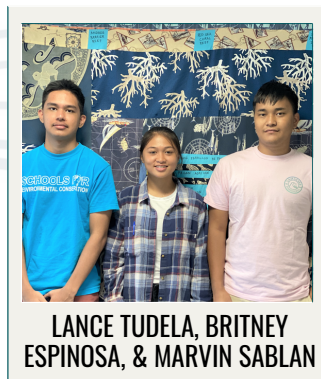
DCRM IS EXCITED TO INTRODUCE THIS YEAR'S INTERNSHIP COHORT

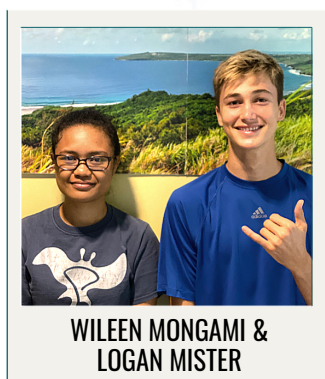

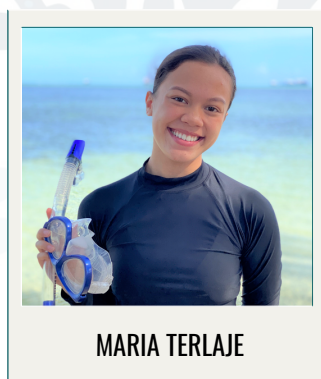
Daniel is an intern at the Division of Environmental Quality, Pesticides Branch under the guidance of Zabrina Shai, Pesticides Program Manager.



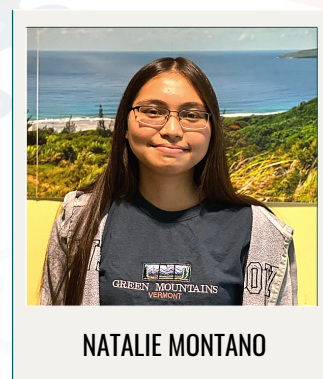
Jefferzon is an intern at the Division of Coastal Resources Management, Enforcement Section under the guidance of Tom Pangelinan, Enforcement Officer III.



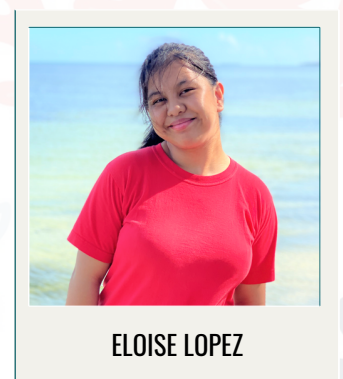
