- A. Project: CMS KANNAT TABLA QUARRY – The Construction and Materials Supply, Inc. (CMS) is currently engaging in quarrying activities of an old and existing quarry site located on two leased public land properties in Kannat Tabla, specifically identified as Lot Nos. 035 H 01 and 035 H 02. Total area for the two lots is approximately 60,481 square meters, more or less.

- B. Project: CMS SOLTEN QUARRY – The Construction and Material Supply, LLC (CMS) is requesting to extend its existing quarry operation in San Vicente, Saipan. This project is permitted under CRM Major Siting Permit No. SMS-97-X-59 and in 2016, CMS amended its permit to expand its rock quarry operation on approximately 20,800 square meters of private land identified as Lot No. 062 H 03. The proposed operation is projected to yield about one million cubic yards of limestone materials over a period of 10 years.

CMS issued a letter dated September 7, 2018 requesting to renew Permit No. SMS-97-X-59, Amendment 2006 to continue its quarry operations for a period of ten years or more with an option to renew for an additional term depending on the extraction rate driven by the demand for quarry products in the CNMI. Furthermore, CMS will not be changing its use and project yield of one million cubic yards of extracted materials but would like to include a temporary use for stockpiling of aggregates being extracted from nearby CMS quarry sites.
