The Division of Coastal Resources Management (DCRM) will be holding a public hearing for the proposed resumption of RMIC's Rock Crushing and Rock Quarry Operations project at As Matuis, Saipan.

Resources Management International Corporation (RMIC) is proposing to resume the rock crushing and rock quarry operations. The project includes extracting raw corals and limestone materials. The project site is situated on public land identified as Lot No. 069 A 01, measuring approximately 20,000 square meters.
