NOTICE: The Bureau of Environmental and Coastal Quality (BECQ) Division of Coastal Resources Management (DCRM) is currently reviewing a federal consistency determination from the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) for a proposed catch limit of 2000 metric tons (t) of longline-caught bigeye tuna per US Pacific territory for 2021. NMFS would also allow territories to allocate up to 1500 t to US longline fishing vessels in agreements that meet established criteria. Federal consistency is a provision of the Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) that requires federal actions that affect the coastal zone to be consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the enforceable policies of a coastal state's federally approved coastal management plan.
