DEADLINE: MAY 26, 2022

Contaminated stormwater is a major threat to coral reef health in the CNMI!

When it rains, stormwater picks up a number of pollutants and carries it into the ocean. Harvesting rainwater through rain barrels reduces the volume of runoff and helps improve the quality of our waters and coral reefs.



What does a healthy coral reef ecosystem look like to you?

HOW TO ENTER:

- Contestants must be 13 years of age or older.
- Create a preliminary design related to the theme!
- Submit your **design <u>AND</u> entry form** (can be found on the DCRM website) to the DCRM office **by May 26, 2022** for judging.
 - o 3rd Floor, BECQ Building, Middle Road, Gualo Rai
- **Top 5 designs** will be notified to pick up their rain barrels and art supplies for painting.
 - TOP 5 DESIGNS WILL BE SELECTED BASED ON:
 CREATIVITY, NEATNESS, AND THEME RELEVANCY
- Painting of rain barrels must be completed by June 10, 2022!

ELIGIBILITY

- Participants must be 13 years of age or older to join.
- Participants ages 13-17 must have a parent/legal guardian fill out and sign the Rain Barrel Art Contest Entry Form.

HOW TO ENTER

- Participants will need to create a preliminary design of the actual artwork to be incorporated onto the rain barrel.
- The design must be relevant to the theme: What does a healthy coral reef ecosystem look like to you?
- You may use any standard size paper (8.5"x11") or larger for submission.
- A filled out and signed Rain Barrel Art Contest Entry Form <u>must</u> be submitted together with your design; otherwise, the artwork will <u>not</u> be accepted.

ARTWORK SELECTION

- Judging will be based on <u>creativity</u>, <u>neatness</u>, <u>and theme relevancy</u> of preliminary design.
- Top 5 designs will be notified to pick up their rain barrel and art supplies at the DCRM office.
- Participants must have their rain barrel completely painted and dropped off at the DCRM office no later than <u>Friday</u>, <u>June 10</u>, <u>2022</u>.

DISPLAY & JUDGING AT OCEAN FAIR

- Top 5 designs will have will have their painted rain barrels on display at DCRM's Saipan Ocean Fair on June 11, 2022, for community judging.
- The Top 2 Rain Barrels with the most votes will be awarded the *People's Choice Award*.
- All Top 5 finalists will keep their painted rain barrels after the display and voting period.

ART SUPPLIES TO BE PROVIDED

- One (1) 55 gal. rain barrel
- Two (2) qt. primer
- Two (2) cans of spray-on sealant
- Assorted paintbrushes (1"- 2 1/2")
- One (1) qt. red paint
- One (1) qt. yellow paint
- One (1) qt. blue paint
